The Sense of Taste -- Some Useful Classifications

to taste something - savor, sip, taste

to give taste to something - flavor, season, spice

a taste - flavor, savor, taste

an agent to alter taste - flavor, seasoning, spice

sweet tasting - acid, curdled

sharp tasting - bitter, salty, sharp, tangy, tart, vinegary

hot or spicy tasting - biting, gingery, hot, peppery, spiced, spicy

bland tasting or tasteless - bland, flavorless, insipid, tasteless, unflavored, unpalatable, unseasoned

ripe tasting - mellow, ripe

unripe tasting - green, unripe

spoiled tasting - curdled, rotten, spoiled, tainted

good tasting - appetizing, delicious, flavorsome, luscious, tasty, yummy

bad tasting - biting, bitter, distasteful, nauseating, rotten, sour, spoiled, stale, tainted, tasteless, unappetizing, unpalatable, unripe, unseasoned, vinegary

having a taste - flavored, high-seasoned, seasoned, spiced
